5.	Neither Woodrock Animal Rescue, nor its employees, directors, affiliates,	
	or volunteers will be held responsible for any damages, loss of property	
	or injury as a result of an animal adoption from our facilitate.	

	General rules of Woodrock Animal Rescue adoption	Sign block to indicate your agreement.
1.	This animal will always be treated with dignity, kindness and love in a	
	permanent and stable home environment.	
2.	It is the adopter's responsibility to ensure that this animal always has	
	access to food, clean drinking water and any medical treatment it may	
	need, as well as ensure its emotional well-being for the rest of its life.	
	You are furthermore required to provide the animal with adequate	
	shelter from the elements.	
3.	No animal adopted from Woodrock Animal Rescue is permitted to be	
	used for guarding or security services, or for exhibition/ performance	
	purposes.	
4.	Should you, for any reason in the future, be unable to keep this animal,	
	you will immediately advise Woodrock Animal Rescue and surrender the	
	animal to our shelter to be rehomed. Woodrock Animal Rescue have the	
	discretion to charge a return fee of R1000. 00. Under no circumstances	
	are you allowed to rehome, sell or transfer ownership of the animal to	
	anyone else, without written consent from Woodrock Animal Rescue.	
5.	If the animal has escaped from your property or if you suspect it has	
	been stolen, you are required to report such to Woodrock Animal	
	Rescue within 24 hours.	
6.	All animals on the property must be sterilised. If adopting a puppy or	
	kitten, you agree to have it sterilised by 6 months of age.

I understand that adopting an animal from Woodrock Animal Rescue means I will	
be subject to a property inspection. Should my property be deemed unsuitable for	
this animal, the adoption application will be null & void.	
I understand that this animal remains the property of Woodrock Animal Rescue and	
that I will adhere to the general rules for adoption as stated above.	
I am adopting this animal from Woodrock Animal Rescue in the full knowledge that	
no refunds are given should the animal no longer suit my circumstances,	
expectations, or house-training requirements.	
I understand that from the moment of adopting this animal, I will be fully responsible	
for any costs connected to this animal, including feeding, medical expenses,	
vaccinations, and any other costs that may arise from this animal.	
Woodrock Animal Rescue has the right to discuss my adoption with any other	
animal welfare organization and or veterinary clinics.	
I will allow Woodrock Animal Rescue to inspect this animal and my property at any	
reasonable time in the future.	
I understand that it may take time for this animal to settle into its new home and I	
will give it a reasonable period and patience to adapt to its new environment.	
If I am adopting a puppy or a kitten, that is under the age of six months, I	
undertake to bring the animal back to Woodrock Animal Rescue or any	
affiliated vets, on or before the expiry date indicated on the sterilisation	
voucher given to me, to complete the sterilisation surgery.	
I have never been convicted of cruelty to animals or any crime regarding the theft,	
illegal trade, or export of animals.	
In the event of my address / residence changing, I will provide my new contact	
details to Woodrock Animal Rescue with immediate effect.	
This animal will not be chained or caged at any time, and I will not violate the	
Animal Protection Act 71 of 1962.	
I am over the age of 21 and that I am financially able to care for this animal.	
I understand that if I do not comply with the general rules of adoption, as stated	
above, that this animal may be immediately confiscated and that I will be liable for	
any legal, medical or rehabilitation costs that may arise.	
We respect your right to privacy and therefore aim to ensure that we comply with
